## EU Mandatory Supply Chain Due Diligence

#### **CBAM**

Iron & steel, cement, fertilizers, aluminium, electricity, hydrogen, certain precursors and downstream products

### **Deforestation Regulation**

Cattle, cocoa, coffee, palm oil, rubber, soy, wood, and their derived products

#### Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence

Cross-sectoral to all large EU and non-EU companies over a certain threshold and to smaller companies in high-impact sectors

#### **Battery Regulation**

All batteries and waste batteries, and their raw materials (cobalt; natural graphite; lithium; nickel; and chemical compounds based on the raw materials listed)

#### **Conflict Minerals**

Minerals or metals containing or consisting of tin, tantalum, tungsten or gold

### Forced Labour Regulation

All manufactured products imported to or exported from the EU made with forced labour
